WHO ARE NEXT WAVE INTERNS?

FULL-TIME COLLEGE STUDENTS

The typical Next Wave intern carries a minimum of 12 credits per semester. This student may be enrolled at any accredited college, not necessarily Northwest University. They often feel called to vocational ministry.

ADULT PROFESSIONALS

These are adult learners who may or may not be receiving practicum credits. Interns with families and jobs find Next Wave enables them to finish their degrees or credentialed minister programs at a highly discounted rate and still fulfill their other responsibilities.

TRADE SCHOOL STUDENTS

Some Next Wave interns are attending trade schools and want to prepare to lead in their local church. The on-campus leadership classes, Assemblies of God credentialed minister program, and ministry-specific mentorship prepares them to be leaders.
