### Summary

Continuing on in 1st Corinthians, Dr. Brian Jenkins and Pastor Miles Langrock are looking at chapter 3. The author Paul is continuing to warn the Corinthians against adding rogue beliefs onto the foundation of Christ, following leaders who are not servants first, and talking about what spiritually mature Christians really look like.
